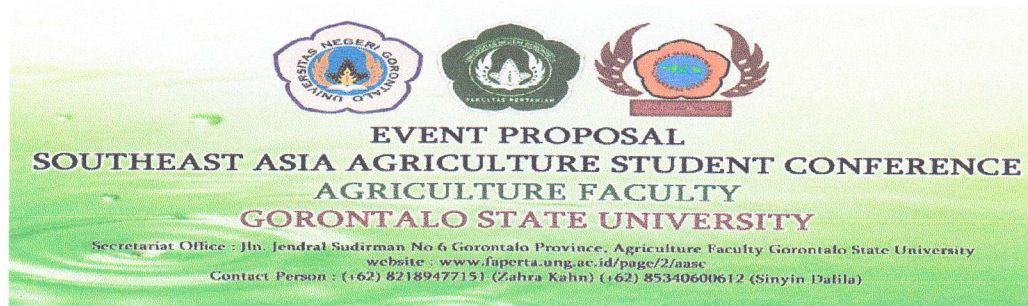

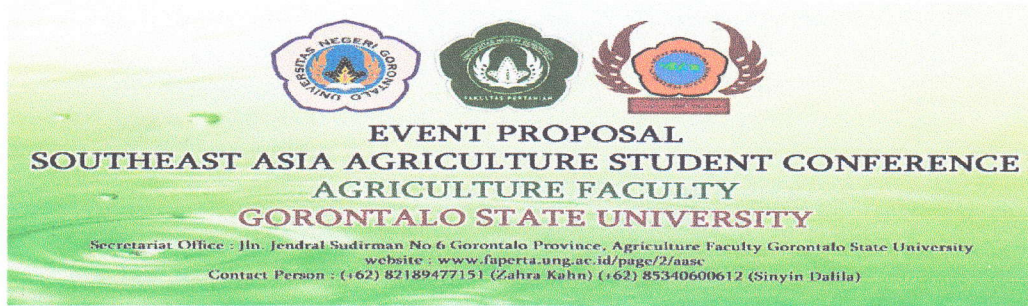


Background

Activity Purpose

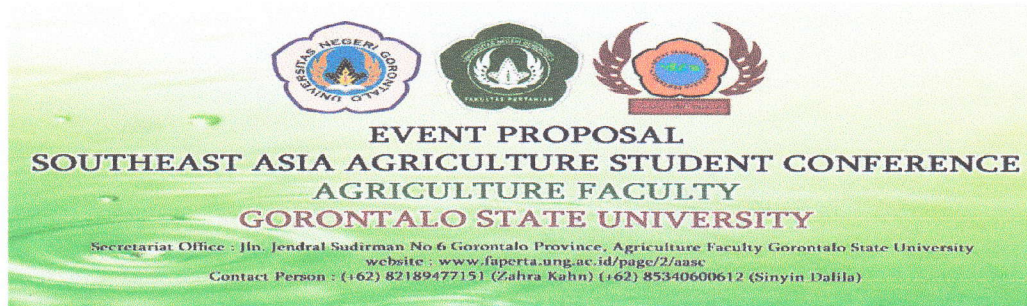
1. Explore the potential and interest of student with a background in agriculture

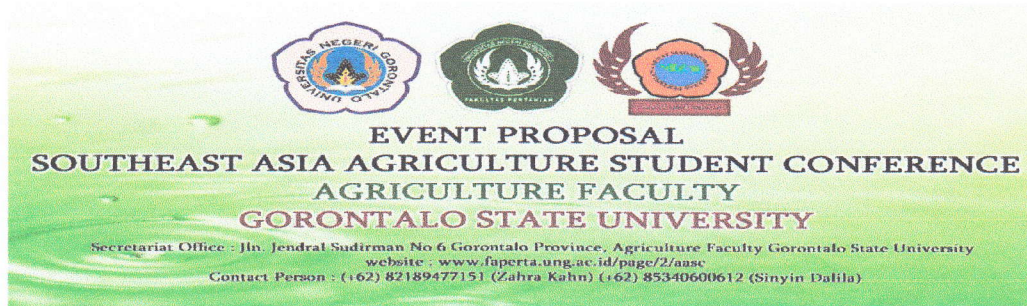
